In step with the economic downturn, the Slovak construction industry experienced a substantial decline in 2009 after a decade of growth on all fronts. The least affected area was civil engineering, which generated a significant fraction of construction output in Slovakia in 2009, succeeding somewhat in offsetting the decline in the industry. Nonetheless, construction activity slumped by about 10% in Slovakia last year. In 2010, partially thanks to base effects, the Slovak construction industry will be back on the path of growth, with civil engineering becoming more prominent on the construction market in Slovakia.

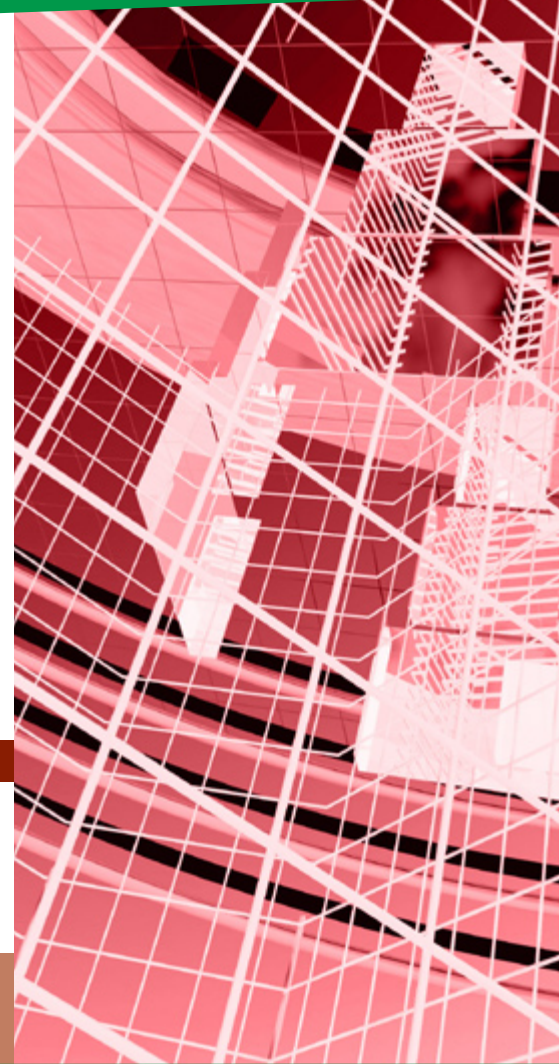
